AREA: 3,393 square kilometres

TERRITORIAL AUTHORITY: Tasman District Council

DESCRIPTION OF PERMIT AREA:

All the area of land extending offshore parallel to the coast from Kahurangi Point on the West Coast of the South Island to Separation Point in Golden Bay, extending out to the 12 nautical mile limit but excluding a 2 mile buffer zone north and a 4 nautical mile buffer zone south around Farewell Spit, as shown on the plan attached.
